



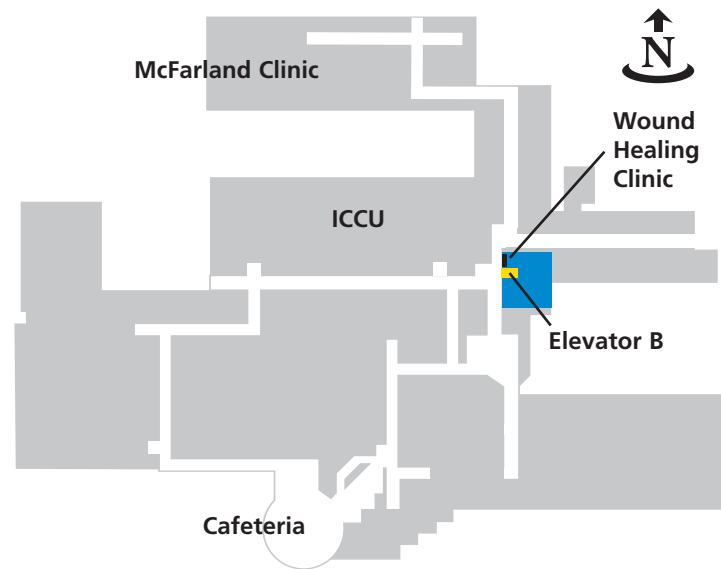

Wound Healing Clinic

Most wounds, minor cuts and scratches heal on their own within two weeks.

Sometimes a wound stays open longer due to infection, blood flow problems, diabetes or poor nutrition. The specially trained clinical team at the Wound Healing Clinic at Mary Greeley Medical Center can help those wounds that just would not heal on their own.

Types of wounds treated:

- Diabetic ulcers
- Pressure ulcers
- Arterial ulcers
- Venous ulcer
- Trauma
- Cellulitis
- Any wound that has not healed in one month

The clinic helps chronic wounds heal faster by treating the cause of the non-healing wound and applying evidence-based, medical and surgical techniques that are outcome-focused and cost-effective.

Treatments methods include:

- Advanced wound dressings
- Vacuum-assisted closure
- Bioengineered tissue
- Debridement
- Wraps to decrease lower leg swelling
